The Jewish Hospital Visitor's Parking Garage is a 7 level garage with approximately 30,300 square feet per level. The garage is constructed of precast concrete double tees, spandrel beams, inverted tee beams and concrete columns. The garage has experienced deterioration over its life span due to water intrusion and lack of proper maintenance. The major structural concerns result from cracked and spalled double tee flanges at the joints, and cracked and spalled spandrel beams. Cornerstone Engineering was contracted to perform a structural condition assessment and report of findings and prepare design drawings for the recommended areas of repair. Cornerstone will also work closely with the Contractor during construction to ensure proper implementation of the design drawings.
